#### Professional Requirements / Education and Experience

- Must have full approval and certification as a school psychologist by the Michigan Department of Education or eligibility for temporary approval.
- Must have completed a graduate degree in an approved school psychology certification program.
- Preference will be given to applicants who have successful prior experience as a school psychologist.
- Thorough understanding of special education laws, regulations and processes.
- Demonstrated aptitude for work to be performed, such as, but not limited to: positive work ethic, well
  organized, strong communication skills, basic technology skills, and flexibility to work effectively with
  diverse students and staff.
- Ability to provide positive behavioral support to students in a group and in an individual setting.
- Knowledge of management techniques and instructional use of computers will enhance the candidate's ability to perform job duties.
- Must pass a criminal history background investigation conducted by the Michigan State Police (MSP) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI).

- Support students' ability to learn and the teacher's ability to teach through consultation and intervention.
