REQUIREMENTS:


- Ability to work well with people and maintain productive and positive interpersonal skills.
- Master's Degree or equivalent with five or more years of teaching experience in Grades Pre K-5.
- Demonstrated success with teaching students at-risk in the area of reading.
- Michigan endorsement with approval or certification in reading.
- Knowledge of current Pre K-5 state literacy standards.
- Instructional skills and knowledge base in early literacy components, including the Essential Instructional Practices in Early Literacy.
- Familiarity and success with utilizing formative, screening, and diagnostic tools with students to determine appropriate reading instruction.
- Ability to utilize data from diagnostic tools to determine additional extra supports needed in order to read at grade level by the end of 3rd grade.
- Applicants must possess a valid Michigan driver's license.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Reading Specialist certification or the equivalent amount of training focused on research-based practices.
- Cognitive Coaching and/or Adaptive Schools training.
- The administration and use of data from the universal screeners and benchmarking/progress monitoring assessments.
- Ability to use observational data and formative assessment processes to guide professional learning and coaching.
- The use of technology as an instructional and organizational tool.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Participate in required training for Michigan ISD Pre K-5 Literacy Coaches.
- Data collection and evaluation related to the grant.
- Promote high-quality, evidence-based practices in literacy Pre K through 5th grade.



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- Provide coaching to identified local Literacy Coaches in order to support and promote the Essentials work in classrooms throughout the MOISD.
- Work with school districts in assessing needs and integrating Multi-Tiered Systems of Support for Pre K-5 literacy, including coaching building-level teams in the analysis of data.
- Develop and model high-quality literacy lessons and units for Pre K-5 teachers.
- Coach one-on-one in high needs Pre K-5 classrooms, building and maintaining confidential relationships.
- Serve as a regional source for development and delivery of professional development related to research-based literacy strategies and interventions for teachers of Grades Pre K-5.
- Support the integration of technology in effective literacy instruction.
- Participate in school improvement activities focused on improving instructional practices as evidenced by student outcomes in Grades Pre K-5.
- Remain knowledgeable about current research and pedagogical recommendations relevant to the coaching role.
- Provide training and support with the implementation of a comprehensive system of literacy instruction.
- Assist local districts in identifying strengths and needs in support of an early literacy continuum.
- Manage time as needed for completion of duties, and attend meetings outside of regular working hours.
- Participate as an active team member with teachers, school administrators, and other professionals to create safe, healthy, and supportive learning environments.
- Maintain a cooperative, harmonious relationship with professionals and others within the school setting.
- Follow all established policies, practices, and procedures in terms of duties and responsibilities of the position.
- Assume the responsibility to transport yourself to the assigned worksite(s).
- Maintain regular and reliable attendance.
- Perform other duties and responsibilities as may be assigned by the Director of General Education or designee.
